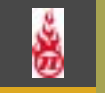

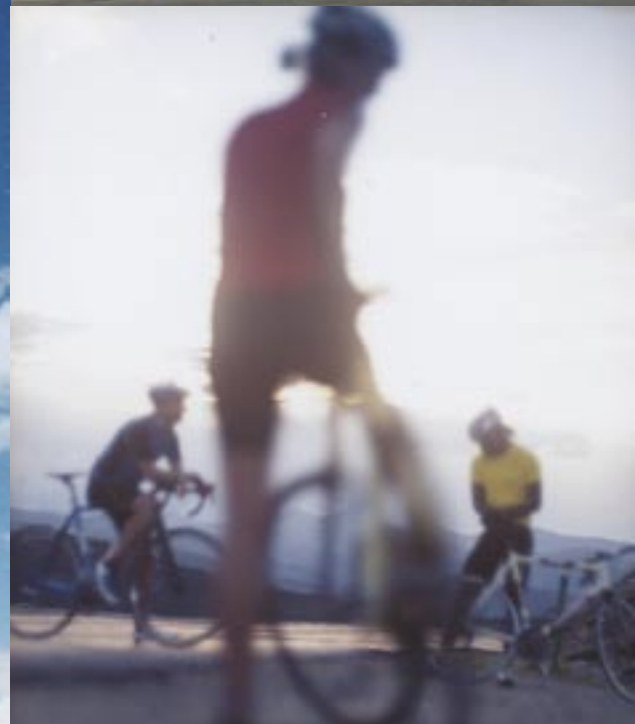

Bottom line is that the eXpress is really what every bike should be: fast, light, versatile, and really fun to ride. 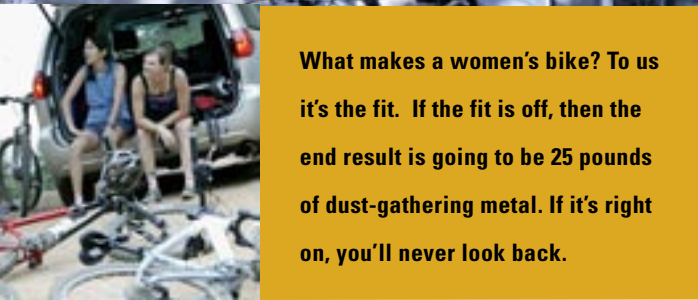

BONITA | We built the Bonita supertough, ready to take whatever you throw at it. Show no mercy. Really. Its superbomber 6061 aluminum frame can take it. Plus, we matched it up with Manitou's Axel Comp fork, which will soak up anything really nasty that pops up on the trail. Rocks, roots, gophers. You name it. And lest you think we want you to crash headlong into a tree, we've hung a set of Shimano disc brakes to keep even the biggest downhills manageable. Of course, as on all of our women's bikes, we've dialed in the fit at all critical contact points. This includes Truvativ bar and stem, plus WTB's Speed She saddle, designed for women. Suspension forks smooth out rougher terrain, and a wide gear range provides ample choices for hitting the hills or trails. Excellent brakes keep it all under control.
