CAMPSITE ESSENTIALS

Tent & Shelter:

- Tent
 - Shade shelter
 - Sleeping pads, air mattresses or cots
 - Sleeping bag or blanket
 - Pillows
 - Eyeshades, earplugs
- ### **Camp Furniture:**
- Camp chairs or hammocks
 - Folding table or camp kitchen
 - Clothesline
 - Tapestries or sheets for additional privacy

Camp Entertainment:

- Music player, speakers and headphones
- Solar charger
- Headlamps or flashlights (*with extra batteries*)
- Lantern and string lights
- Outdoor games

Camp Kitchen:

- Cooler
- Camp stove
- Fuel or charcoal (*with matches, lighter*)
- Plates and bowls, drinkware and eating utensils
- Camping cookware (*such as pots, pans, cooking utensils like a spatula or cutting board, multi-tool or knife*)
- Portable coffee or espresso maker
- Other kitchen items like bottle opener, corkscrew, food-storage containers, trash bags

Camp Hygiene:

- Camp sink and sponge(s)
- Biodegradable soap
- Quick-dry towels or paper towels
- Camp shower
- Extra toilet paper or pee cloth
- Hand sanitizer
