- ☐ Socks (*synthetic or wool*)

- ☐ Insulating jacket or vest
- ☐ Warm hat
- ☐ Gloves
- ☐ Rain jacket and rain pants
- ☐ Clothesline with clips
- ☐ In-camp sandals or booties
