## FOOTPRINT INSTRUCTIONS

- Lay out the footprint, coated side up.
- Pitch your tent (without the rainfly) and align the tent floor outline to match the orientation of the footprint: The color-coded webbing on the corner-tabs should match.
- **3.** Insert tent-pole tips into the grommets on the footprint's corner tabs.
- 4. Attach the rainfly. When attaching rainfly grommets to the poles, place them last on the pole tips, underneath the footprint grommets. When finished, you will have 3 layers of grommets on the tips: tent floor corner tabs (top), footprint (middle) and rainfly (bottom).
- Stake out your tent.

## NOTE:

The footprint is designed to fit loosely to keep the tent floor taut.

## MINIMALIST SHELTER INSTRUCTIONS

Want to travel ultralight? Use this footprint, your tent's rainfly and poles to create an ultralight tentless shelter.

- If you're new to pitching your tent, refer to its setup instructions.
- To pitch your minimalist shelter, perform the same setup, but omit the tent body and place pole tips into the footprint's corner grommets. Be sure to secure all rainfly rip-and-stick wraps around poles.
- Whenever you're sliding grommets onto pole tips, make sure the rainfly grommets are underneath the footprint grommets.
- When you're done with setup, readjust the rainfly tension. You can also reposition and stake out your minimalist shelter.
