

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

## CHECK INSIDE THE SHELTER BAG FOR:

- Sunshade canopy
- Pole bag and stake bag
- 11 shockcorded poles = 4 guylines with tighteners
- 4 stakes



- Make sure you have a 10' x 10' area for the roof-pole frame. See above for the following steps:
- Assemble the 4-piece ridge pole (it has orange end-hubs), laying it in the middle of the setup area.
- Assemble the 2 side poles: Each has 4 pieces, a green hub on one end and a blue hub on the other end. Lay poles parallel to the ridge pole, about 5' to each side. Same-color end-hubs should be diagonally opposite one another.
- Connect ridge pole to side poles using the 2-piece poles: Slide a pole in until its spring/lock pops into a slot. (See above, center.)

- Assemble the 4 leg poles: Each has 3 sections and 1 end plug that will rest on the ground.
- Raise the roof-pole frame by attaching each leg pole to a roofpole corner-hub. Make sure each spring/lock pops into a slot on a corner-hub. (See above.)
- Drape the canopy over the pole frame, making sure its center seam aligns with the ridge pole.
- Slip the 4 metal rings on canopy's bottom corners over the leg poles' ground-side end plugs. (See above, right.)

- Hook rip-and-stick wraps around the canopy's 4 corner poles. (There are 2 wraps on each corner pole.)
- Tension the canopy by tightening the buckles on the webbing on each corner pole. (See above.)
- The shelter can now be moved to its final location and staked to the ground. Use the stakes provided and the 4 webbing loops at the bottom of the canopy legs. Guylines can also be attached if conditions are windy.
